1. Pick one experience/activity per week that you have done such as eating at a restaurant, bowling, something with your family, church...etc. for the next four weeks. (May 1-May 28) The project is due Tuesday, May 31. If you do more than four entries you will get extra credit in English.
2. Keep a scrap/souvenir from that activity.
3. Display your scrap with a story about the experience. Neatly and legibly write at least 75 words. Hide the story under the scrap or somewhere on the page.
4. Present your "Journal" in a creative way like the example you saw in class. Be sure you have a cover with your name and the date on it on the lower right front corner! Your grade will be based on creativity, correct punctuation, capitalization, spelling, complete sentences, indented paragraphs.... Use the things we have learned in English about writing good sentences. Watch for run-on sentences and sentence fragments. Don't start your sentences with "and".
