Rules and Regulations

Season

The court will be available year round except during the maintenance period. Typically the prime time for Paddle Tennis runs from Mid October until early May

Court Time

Courts will be available for play in 1 ½ hour increments starting at 7:30 AM and running until 9PM. Access to the court will be via a key pad locking system or combination lock. Members may reserve a weekly court time throughout the season but not during the three weekday prime time slots of 4:30PM, 6PM and 7:30PM nor over the weekend.

Reservations

Reservations may be made through the online system hosted on our webpage. Players may play without reservations but will give way to those that have reserved as long as the reserved players arrive within 15 minutes of their scheduled court time.

Access to the courts and storage bin

The building and the court have a number combination lock on the doors. Please contact Scott Phillips for combination. When leaving the building, make sure all the heaters and lights are turned off. All garbage should be removed, leave no trace.

Non-Member Usage

Guest play is limited to 5 x per season. Houseguests are excluded from this policy.

Lights

The light switch is located at the nearest corner to the parking area. Members are expected to turn off the lights when they finish play. Lights do burn out and the Officers will do their best to have them replaced expeditiously. If a light burns out call Scott Phillips, 207-363-1512

Snow Removal

The access road, parking area and path to the first court may be plowed by a plowing service but often it will not be. Members and their guests are to use caution while on the Club's leased property and, per the By-Laws, hold the Club and its Directors harmless should any injury or accident occur. Players will be responsible to clear any snow off the courts with push shovels provided by YPTC.

Heaters

The switch for the two propane bullet heaters is located next to the light switch. Heaters may be turned on by players to melt any remaining ice after the snow has been pushed off the court. Players are responsible to turn the heaters off. Gas service will be provided by Estes Oil whose name and number are on the propane tank. Players are to call Scott Phillips, 207-363-1512 for refills or maintenance.

Parking

Parking is to be in the designated parking area unless there is an overflow and then the access road can be used. The road is just 12' wide so use caution when parking and driving past parked cars.

Clubhouse

The members have built the building for the membership for daily use and social events. Please make sure all lights and heaters are turned off. Please make sure you leave the building and area as you found it or better. All garbage should be removed. Kids are allowed in the building, with parent supervision.

Decorum

All Players and guests are expected to be mindful of our neighbors, the maintenance of the court, clubhouse and grounds.
