I. Call to Order

Welcome- President Dawn Green called the meeting to order.

II. Discussion: Revised Policy 400

Policy 400 would no longer allow full-time instructors to receive compensation at the overload rate. Starting in Fall of 2008, all full-time faculty members teaching classes above their required course load would be paid on the adjunct scale (which is paid to our part-time instructors.)

(1) After considerable discussion, here is the statement we decided as a faculty body to use:

We, the Faculty of Central Texas College, would like to formally express our concern and disappointment in the exclusion of faculty input in the development of Policy 400. Therefore, we propose that Policy 400 be tabled for one year in order to examine its impact on academic programs and their faculty.

(2) A committee consisting of Dr. Tim Anderson, Delores Williams, Lisa Volle` and Dawn Green volunteered to meet with the Chancellor to discuss revised policy 400.

(3) *[After the committee met with the Chancellor, President Dawn Green sent faculty members a memo stating that Dr. Anderson had agreed to delay the implementation of revised policy 400 for one year, as we had requested.]*
