

Central Texas College Faculty Association Meeting      August 26, 2009

The meeting was called to order in the Nursing and Science Building, room 1075. The minutes from the last meeting were tabled.

The President, Delores Williams, gave a brief message reflecting on the activities of the past term of the Faculty Senate: We continue investigating issues regarding textbooks in the bookstore; acknowledgement of the success of the College Success course (Psyc 1300)-noting the sign on campus announcing it; sharing of faculty activity reports with faculty as well as Dr. Anderson and the Board of Trustees; we are in our second year of preparing a budget for the Faculty Association; and we are in the process of evaluating the current format of Faculty Senate and ask for faculty input; we are in the process of writing policies and procedures to accompany the Constitution and by-laws; and we are now listed on the Board of Trustees meeting agendas. Ms. William also thanked past Faculty Senate officers for their service as well as committee members.

The meeting was then turned over to our current President, Jenny Shotwell. Ms. Shotwell brought up the unfinished business of nomination for President Elect for this year, Rick Hindman. Mr. Hindman ran unopposed for this position and was announced as the new President Elect.
