

Area Nets

The following is a list of area nets that may be useful (courtesy of [FHARA](#) and edited by [Mike KB2CCD](#))

Central District Emergency net (CDEN) – meets on the 147.00 W2QYT repeater on an as needed basis. There is a link between the 147.00 - 145.33 KB2AUJ and the 147.225 KB2FAF repeaters to help expand coverage. PL is 71.9. CDEN is the District Emergency Coordinator's training and communication net for Cayuga, Seneca, Oneida, Madison, Onondaga and Oswego counties. The goal is to provide a designated contact point in the event of a large scale emergency for mutual aid and communication.

Onondaga County Radio Emergency net - meets on the first and third Mondays of each month on 147.30(+) for both ARES and RACES members in the Onondaga County Radio Emergency Corp. OCREN WA2PUU is Onondaga County Emergency Coordinator.

6 CARES (6 County ARES) or (SCARES) net - 1st Monday of every month - 7 pm on 3.925 MHz LSB. **SCARES** serves the six county areas of Herkimer, Otsego, Delaware, Chenango, Schoharie, and Montgomery counties.

Oneida County Traffic & Emergency net (OCTEN) – Local NTS net for the Greater Oneida County area. Early Session Week Days at 6:30 pm 146.760 - with call-ups about 6:35 pm on the following frequencies: 145.110 - 145.170 - 146.610 - 146.655 - 146.940 – 146.850 -146.880 -. Late Session Nightly at 9:30 pm 145.170 – or 146.880 - with a 9:35 pm call up on the 145.760 – and either the 145.170 – or 146.880 – (which ever freq is not the primary Net frequency).

Oneida - Madison Emergency net (OMEN) - 7:15 pm 1st & 3rd Tuesday of the Month on the 145.170 –

Oneida – Madison Red Cross and Hospital Radio Checks – 9 am 2nd Friday of each month on each of the ARES frequencies.

Otsego County ARES / RACES net - 7 pm every Thursday 146.850

Herkimer County ARES / RACES net - 7 pm Monday 145.110 – PL 167.9 DTMF. Key in 325 to disable PL Tone. Alt frequencies are 147.090 / no PL and 147.045 / PL 167.9.

Montgomery County ARES / RACES net - 7 pm Thursday 147.195+

New York State RACES net - 9 am Sunday 3.993.5 MHz. Weekly

New York Phone net – 1 pm 3.925 Alt 7.235 MHz week ends. NY Phone is a state wide NTS net.

New York Public Operations - 5 pm 3.912 / 3.925 MHz Daily. NYPON is a state wide NTS net.

Red Cross New England net - 8 pm 3.915 MHz 1st Wednesday of the month (+ or – 5 kHz)

New York State ARES - 3.925 MHz as needed

Second Region Traffic Handlers Information net - (SRTHIN) Every Monday following the (NYPON) net about 5:20 pm on 3.925 MHz
