The St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES will offer the Spring 2012 SAT Workshop to interested high-school juniors who plan to take the SAT in May or June. Classes will be held at the St. Lawrence Valley Educational Services Center, 30 Court Street, Canton, on eight Sundays starting February 26th. Sally Vrooman will teach the Critical Reading and Writing classes and Meg Clemens will teach the Math classes.

Workshop classes are three hours long to simulate an actual SAT test-taking experience, although the SAT takes 3 hours and 45 minutes! Classes are offered on Sundays so students will have fewer conflicts with extra-curricular activities. This course includes 24 hours of in-class preparation as well as out-of-class test practice.

Interested students should talk with their guidance counselors. Registration materials for the Spring 2012 SAT Workshop are available at your school's Guidance office. To participate in the workshop, students in Canton, Clifton-Fine, Colton-Pierrepoint, Gouverneur, Hermon-DeKalb, Heuvelton, Madrid-Waddington and Morristown districts must register with their guidance counselors before February 3rd.
