If you do not have this test done before the correct class, you will not get much out of the first hour of class. DO ALL THREE MATH SECTIONS in each practice test. [Total number of questions = 54] I recommend you enter your answers in the online version of the test at www.collegeboard.org/SATstudyguide. It will compute your score automatically and give a report of your right and wrong answers. (Select Question-Answer, section #, Print Report) We are using the 2nd edition SAT Study Guide.
