

STUDENT INFORMATION SHEET
--SPRING '12 SAT WORKSHOP--

WHAT? SAT Reading and Writing will be taught by Sally Vrooman and SAT Math will be taught by Meg Clemens. The workshop will foster test familiarity, reading, writing and math score improvement, confidence, and efficient time management. The workshop offers eight three-hour classes (24 hours of instruction) beginning February 26 and ending April 29. Students must register with their guidance counselors before February 3. **Sections are assigned as registration forms are received.** Contact Meg Clemens directly about late registrations.

WHO? High-school juniors who plan to take the SAT in May or June.

WHERE? St Lawrence Valley Education Center, 30 Court St, Canton

WHEN? These Sundays: February 26 (RW); March 4 (M), 11 (RW), 18 (M), 25 (M); April 1 (RW), 8 (No Class), 15 (No Class—Possible Snow Day), 22 (M); and 29 (RW). Note that no classes have been scheduled for April 8 and April 15. April 15 is reserved, if necessary, to make-up a snow day. **Please arrive ½ hour early to the first class to purchase your books.** Students can register for one of the following class sessions:

Section #1: Sunday, 11 AM – 2 PM

Section #2: Sunday, 2 PM – 5 PM

Section #3: Sunday, 5 PM – 8 PM

COST? \$135.00 per student plus the \$30.00 cost of required materials.

Canton, Clifton-Fine, Colton-Pierrepont, Gouverneur, Hermon-DeKalb, Heuvelton, Madrid-Waddington and Morristown students should contact their guidance counselor to register. These schools are participating in the BOCES CoSer and the \$135.00 cost for their students may be all or partially paid by the district. Guidance counselors should mail or fax (386-4614) registration forms to Meg Clemens by February 3. Sections are assigned as registration forms are received. Registration confirmations will be emailed to guidance counselors by February 10th. No cancellations allowed.

Students whose schools are not participating in the BOCES CoSer can enroll on a private basis by mailing to Meg Clemens (99 State Street, Canton, NY 13617) the registration form **and** a check for \$135.00 made payable to Sally E. Vrooman. Registration confirmations will be emailed to guidance counselors by February 10th. Home-school students will be telephoned or emailed.

WHAT SHOULD STUDENTS BRING TO THE FIRST CLASS?

1. The PSAT Score Report. Because it profiles a student's reading, writing and math skills, not just the scores, **students need to bring the entire report.** If students do not have it, they should get a complete copy from their guidance counselors. Reports will be returned to students at the last class.
2. Graphing calculator for math classes
3. Note-taking materials
4. **Cash payment for class materials, \$30.00**

Required books and materials will be available for purchase at the first class. *The Official SAT Study Guide: Second Edition* (published by the College Board), Barron's WordMaster cards and a folder are required (cost: \$30.00, includes sales tax). All students should bring CASH to the first class for these purchases; no checks please for books. **Students who miss the first class must arrange with a classmate to purchase the materials or buy the SAT Workshop supplies at the main counter in the SLU Bookstore for \$30.00 BEFORE Class 2 (identify yourself as a SAT Workshop participant.)**
