

Mastodon Exhumation Sites - Town of Montgomery, NY

1829 - Location south of Hill Avenue
Parts of mastodon found

Prior to 1922
vertebra was found

1850 - large mastodon
tooth was found



1845 - Nathaniel Brewster's
Farm - best of any ever found
American Museum of Natural History
Known as the Warren Mastodon.

1814 Farm of Alexander Colden.
One tooth and "locks and tufts o dhair"

1873 - OC Farmer's Museum. sternal
bones, foot bones, four vertebrae,
two ribs were found.

Hartnagel/Bishop reported 1922
skeletal parts found



1801 - Montgomery Mastodon. Captain
Joseph Barber farm. This was the 1st
US Scientific Expedition conducted by
Charles Willson Peale.

1968 - Malley Mastodon. An almost complete
skeleton in good condition was unearthed
during construction of Route 84.



1780 - Reverand Robert Annan Farm
General George Washington visited
here in 1782.
