- ✘ Magazines and gently used books suitable for these age children
- ✘ Plastic and cardboard container (no sharp edges or holes) and (no large boxes)
- ✘ Frozen dinner containers with compartments
- ✘ Egg cartons, communion cups, and cardboard tubes
- ✘ Tin cans with no sharp edges
- ✘ Plastic plant containers
- ✘ Greeting cards and envelopes
- ✘ Stickers including address labels with your name and address cut off
- ✘ Scraps of yarn, material, ribbon, and tissue paper
- ✘ Handmade or other small blankets to be used at naptime
